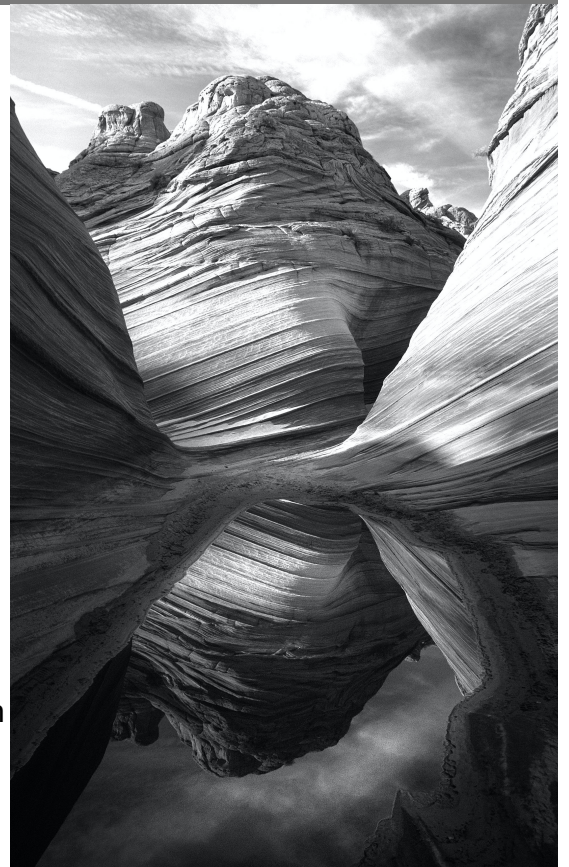
## The View from St. David's
